Know Your Flags

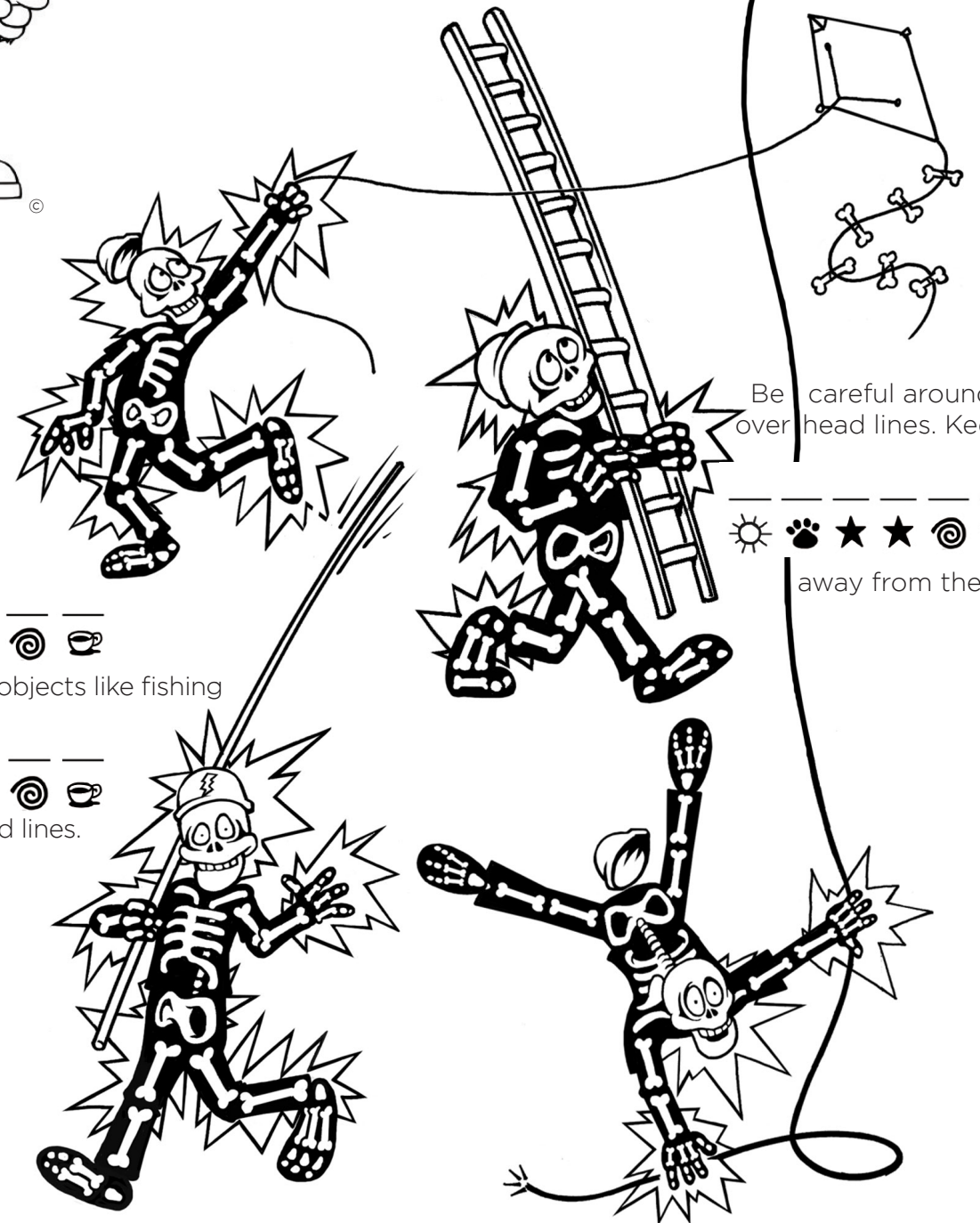
